

## **MEXICO.**

If your Personal Data are processed in Mexico, you may exercise your rights as the data subject according to Federal Law on the Protection of Personal Data of Individuals (DOF 05-07-2010), with its corresponding regulation (DOF 21-12-2011) or any other Law that updates, extends and/or replaces it.

By accepting this Privacy Policy, you accept the processing of your Personal Data and acknowledge that your Personal Data may be transmitted and/or transferred to other countries in which we operate, which may have different Personal Data protection regulations than those established in Mexico. In these cases, the Companies will apply the provisions stipulated in this regard and according to the local regulations that apply to Personal Data.

As the data subject, the Mexican Personal Data Protection Law entitles you to the following rights:

- Right to access the information;
- Right to rectification of Personal Data;
- Right to cancellation of Personal Data;
- Right to opposition to have your Personal Data processed;
- Rights regarding disclosure and communication of data.

The Companies will inform you about the resolution, within a maximum of twenty (20) days, counted from the date on which the request for access, rectification, cancellation or opposition was received, and, if it applies, it will be made effective within fifteen (15) days following the date on which the response is sent. These deadlines may be extended only once for an equal period of time and provided that the circumstances of the case justify it.

The Companies will not be obliged to cancel the information and Personal Data in the cases established in article 26 of the Federal Law on Protection of Personal Data, nor when the owner has a legal or contractual duty to remain in the database, in the terms provided by law.
